ENTRIES CLOSE ON Wednesday July 29, 2020 @ 6PM after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

MEASURING & HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Exhibitors are not required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24" Choice height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog

needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a Temporary Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. . Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge

measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

EQUIPMENT AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on an equine sand, felt & rubber surface by Footing First. Ring size will be 58' by 140'.

First entry of each dog (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee) **\$26**
Each additional entry of same dog (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee) **\$16**

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to **Jeff Abel at trialec@kruisinkanines.com**. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place *Blue*
Second Place *Red*
Third Place *Yellow*
Fourth Place *White*
Qualifying Score *Dark Green*

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. A MACH/PACH rosette and jump bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams qualify for these titles.

* Rosettes will be awarded to teams who earn new titles *

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Aggressive behavior that results in injury of dogs or humans is unacceptable and the trial committee has a duty to investigate and disqualify the dog from AKC events unless there are mitigating circumstances that caused the aggression.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Kruisin Kanines and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Kruisin Kanines reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Kruisin Kanines or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded for entries withdrawn after the closing date in the event handler is injured, absent, dismissed or barred from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, no entry fee will be refunded. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date.

Bitches in season are not eligible to participate. Entry fees will be refunded. Notification for refund of bitches in season must be made no later than the start of judging on the first day of the trial which the bitch was entered. Written verification from a veterinarian is also required.

Sick and injured dogs will get a 50% refund of entry fees. A veterinarian's note is required and must be received by mail or email before the first day of the trial.

Any dog diagnosed, with Kennel Cough or K9 Influenza and any dog domiciled in the same residence, even if not affected, will also receive a 50% refund with receipt of final confirmation.

RINGSIDE

No chairs, coolers, etc. permitted in the waiting area. Waivers may be requested by handicapped individuals.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CRATING AREA

Limited indoor crating **may be** available for the dogs. No exhibitors will be allowed to stay inside the crating area.

Be prepared to work out of your car.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing or at the practice jump.
- Competitors must pick up after their dogs and deposit waste in the outside trash can.
- Reactive dogs will be asked to be crated in owner's vehicle.
- Please drive slowly down the farm road and in the parking lot.
- There is water onsite but not for human consumption. Please come prepared.

FROM THE PA TURNPIKE- From Exit 343 (Willow Grove) of the PA Turnpike From the exit take Rt. 611 North. Follow Rt. 611 North for approximately 14.3 miles (past Doylestown) to the exit for Silo Hill Rd. Then:

FROM 611 NORTH PAST DOYLESTOWN- Take the exit for Silo Hill Road. Follow "Connector A" to Silo Hill Road. Turn right onto Silo Hill Rd. Continue to stop sign and turn left onto Point Pleasant Pike. Continue on Point Pleasant Pike for approximately 4 miles, bear right on to Ferry Road. Follow Ferry Road to second stop sign (4 way stop), turn right onto Tollgate Road. Follow Tollgate Road for approximately 1.5 miles. Sladek Road is a "U" shaped road. Continue past the first entrance to Sladek Rd, to the second Sladek Road and turn left.

FROM SLADEK RD- Follow Sladek Rd around "S" curve (curves right, then left). Before the next curve (which is a 90 degree turn to left), there will be a stone farmhouse on your right (with an address sign out front for 7102C), take the driveway just past this house on the right. There are small blue signs on the right side of the driveway that say 7102. Once you are on the driveway, watch carefully for a barn gate on your left, turn left here; do not continue straight past the "Private Residence" sign. Follow this drive until you are between two barns with tall silos on your right. Park on the grass, anywhere on the right side of the drive. The door to the facility is red, and directly to the right of the silos.

FROM ALLENTOWN/BETHLEHEM AREA Follow Rt309 south to Quakertown. In Quakertown, go east on PA313. Follow PA313 for approximately 9 miles. Turn left on to Stump Rd. Continue on Stump Rd crossing both PA611 and PA413. Approximately 2 miles past the intersection of Stump Rd and PA413, make a right on to Wismer Rd. Continue on Wismer (south), cross Point Pleasant Pike and take the next left onto Ferry Rd. At the next intersection (4 way stop sign), make a right turn on to Tollgate Rd. Follow Tollgate Road for approximately 1.5 miles, to Sladek Rd. Sladek Road is a "U" shaped road, and meets Tollgate in two places: skip the first entrance to Sladek, and continue to the second Sladek Rd and turn left. Follow Sladek Rd directions above.

FROM NEW JERSEY- From Lambertville, NJ take Rt. 179 across the bridge into New Hope. Follow Rt. 179 until you reach Rt. 202. Take Rt. 202 South for approximately 1.8 miles. Turn right on to Aquetong Road. Follow Aquetong road to stop sign, turn right (Rt. 263). Make immediate left turn and continue on Aquetong Road for approximately 2.5 miles into Carversville. Turn left on Carversville road. Turn Right on to Wismer Road. Turn right on to Tollgate Road. Turn Right on to Sladek Road. Follow Sladek Rd directions above.

FROM PHILADELPHIA-Take Rt. 76 West to Rt. 476 North (Blue Route) to PA Turnpike East (will say NJ and East) to exit 343 (Willow Grove) and follow the first set of directions.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
