

SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES

For this trial, the following guidelines will be in affect.

1. The entry limit has changed for Saturday and Sunday from 350 runs to 250 runs per day to make is easier for social distancing.
2. There will not be any chairs or observers on the mezzanine.
3. The gate steward will be outside the doorway to the building. A second gate steward will be inside the building directing people for their runs.
4. The gate steward will be the only person allowed to check in dogs.
5. Only a few exhibitors will be allowed in the building while they are in que for their runs. There will be markings on the floor at 6 foot intervals to emphasize social distancing.
6. Judges briefings will be held outside to maintain a 6 foot distance.
7. The entrance and exit of exhibitors after their runs will be different than in the past to not allow people passing closely while in the building.
8. Anyone entering the building will need to wear a mask which will include all workers and ring crew..
9. Walk throughs will be limited to around 15 people on the course. So depending on the amount of entries in each jump height, there may be multiple walk throughs.
10. Results will be posted outside the building. In addition, results are always emailed to the exhibitors following the trial weekend.
11. Course maps will be posted outside the building. There will not be any paper course maps so plan on taking a picture of the maps. In addition, course maps will be available the night before each day of the trial on the Kruisin Kanines website.
12. There will not be food or beverages at the trial. There will not be a hospitality table. Competitors will need to bring their own food.
13. Worker bucks will be handed out to volunteers to be used at a future trial.
14. We will be streaming the runs through Facebook Live so everyone can watch the runs from their phone or tablet outside the building.
15. Our judge has requested for everyone to wear a mask while running. The PA Dept of Health said it would be best to wear a mask if it is safe to do so while running unless it endangers your ability to breathe. If you plan on running without a mask, you will be required to have your mask on before and after your run. Please be aware of any signs of heat illness and take the necessary precautions to prevent it since it might be a warm day. Also, if you have any kind of respiratory issues, please do not enter this trial. We would rather everyone error on the side of caution.
16. We will be taking the temperature of each person with a non-contact thermometer. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 will be asked to leave the premise and will not be able to participate. If your temperature is below 100.4, you will be asked to wear a wristband which will allow you to enter into the barn. You will not be able to enter the barn without a wristband.
17. We will have **limited** indoor crating for the dogs, but no exhibitors will be able to stay inside with their dogs. So we are asking everyone to come prepared to crate outdoors, if necessary.

Before you enter this trial, be sure you are comfortable with these new guidelines. If anyone doesn't abide by this guidelines, they will be asked to leave this trial. We are hoping everyone will comply with the social distancing guidelines and make this trial comfortable for everyone. This trial will probably be longer than usual, but we feel this will be the most safe way to run this trial.
