DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

ENTRY FEES

An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class. Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run AKC recording fee. Make checks payable to: KRUISIN KANINES

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax or hand delivery. Overnight/Priority Mail entries must include the signature waiver. Inquiries may be directed to Patty Mortara at ScentworkSolutions@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than a five (5) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

ENTRY METHOD, LIMIT, DATES & DRAW LOCATION

Entries for the random draw will be taken between April 5, 2019 at 8AM (Eastern Time) and April 15, 2019 at 5PM (Eastern Time) The drawing will be held on April 15, 2019 at 7PM at Kruisin Kanines' Training Facility, 7102 Sladek Road, Carversville, PA 18913. Entries for the Random Draw will be taken during the Draw Period as stated above. The Random Draw will be held at the location and time stated above. The public is invited to attend. Entries will be accepted until the Closing Date of May 3, 2019 at 5PM (Eastern Time). If published limits are not exceeded during the Draw Period, all entries received after the Draw Period will be accepted under First Received method. If trial limits are exceeded at the Draw, those entries will be added to a wait list in the order received.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

A maximum of **25 entries per day** will be placed and/or added to the wait list. All entries, (including wait listed entries) must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date of May 3, 2019 at 5PM (Eastern Time). No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after the closing of May 3, 2019 at 5PM (Eastern Time). If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Payment / Checks received for a wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list (into the trial) will be shredded by the Kruisin Kanines Treasurer.

GUARANTEED ENTRY FOR WORKERS

Kruisin Kanines will guarantee entries for workers who commit to work an entire trial. Your duties at the trial will not interfere with running your dog. Priority will be given to those with the most volunteer experience. Please write **VOLUNTEER** on the outside of your entry envelope and indicate which trial you are available to work.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area(s) - Will be out of view of search areas. Staging area(s) could include crating, warm-up boxes, waiting area, check-in table/board for posting of running order, as well as the secretary table for posting of results. **The Handler's Briefing** - Will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing. A warm-up area will be available consisting of **ONE** marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. **The Warm-Up Area** - Is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Areas - May be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. Search area conditions may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, concrete or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes - Will be as follows: Container Novice (250-400sqft.), Interior Novice (100-200sqft.), Buried Novice (150-200sqft.), Container Advanced (400-600sqft.), Interior Advanced (200-400sqft.), Buried Advanced (150-200sqft.)

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site - It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. **Possession of Odors and Training** - Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area". **Spectator Area** - Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except

in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search until the completion of the class. **Exhibitors are Responsible for Cleaning up after their Dog(s)** - Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

CRATING SPACE - There will be NO indoor crating available, crating will be from exhibitor's vehicle.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue

Qualifying Search	Dark Green

A New Title Rosette - Will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. If you anticipate earning a title please indicate on the bottom of the Entry Agreement page.

High in Trial - Only teams who participate in all elements offered (Container, Interior, and Buried), and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Trial. One High in Trial winner is chosen per difficulty level; there is no separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win. The winning teams will receive a High in Trial rosette.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Safety, Behavior & Liability - The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Kruisin' Kanines Agility Club of Perkasio and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Kruisin' Kanines Agility Club of Perkasio reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Kruisin' Kanines Agility Club of Perkasio or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses - During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable (only while in the search area). The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the trial grounds! - Retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No Entry Fee - Will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing due to an injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in Season - Are not permitted to compete. Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs - The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitor Check-In - At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email. Exhibitors **MUST** check-in **EACH** for trial they are entered. Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

KRUISIN KANINES TRAINING CENTER 7102 SLADEK ROAD NEW HOPE, PA 18938

From the PA Turnpike – From Exit 343 (Willow Grove) of the PA Turnpike From the exit take Rt. 611 North. Follow Rt. 611 North for approximately 14.3 miles (past Doylestown) to the exit for Silo Hill Rd. Then:

From 611 North past Doylestown – Take the exit for Silo Hill Road. Follow “Connector A” to Silo Hill Road. Turn right onto Silo Hill Rd. Continue to stop sign and turn left onto Point Pleasant Pike. Continue on Point Pleasant Pike for approximately 4 miles, bear right on to Ferry Road. Follow Ferry Road to second stop sign (4 way stop), turn right onto Tollgate Road. Follow Tollgate Road for approximately 1.5 miles. Sladek Road is a “U” shaped road. Continue past the first entrance to Sladek Rd, to the second Sladek Road and turn left.

From Sladek Rd – Follow Sladek Rd around “S” curve (curves right, then left). Before the next curve (a 90 degree turn to left), there will be a stone farmhouse on your right (with an address sign out front for 7102C), take the driveway just past this house on the right. There are small blue signs on the right side of the driveway that say 7102. Once you are on the driveway, watch carefully for a barn gate on your left, turn left here; do not continue straight past the “Private Residence” sign. Follow this drive until you are between two barns with tall silos on your right. Park on the grass, anywhere on the right side of the drive. The door to the facility is red, and directly to the right of the silos.

From Allentown/Bethlehem Area - Follow Rt309 south to Quakertown. In Quakertown, go east on PA313. Follow PA313 for approximately 9 miles. Turn left on to Stump Rd. Continue on Stump Rd crossing both PA611 and PA413. Approximately 2 miles past the intersection of Stump Rd and PA413, make a right on to Wismer Rd. Continue on Wismer (south), cross Point Pleasant Pike and take the next left onto Ferry Rd. At the next intersection (4 way stop sign), make a right turn on to Tollgate Rd. Follow Tollgate Road for approximately 1.5 miles, to Sladek Rd. Sladek Road is a “U” shaped road that meets Tollgate in two places: skip the first entrance to Sladek Rd, continue to the second Sladek Rd sign and turn left. Follow Sladek Rd directions above.

From New Jersey – take Rte. 202 into New Hope, PA. Take Rt. 202 South for approximately 1.8 miles. Turn right on to Aquetong Road. Follow Aquetong road to stop sign, turn right (Rt. 263). Make immediate left turn and continue on Aquetong Road for approximately 2.5 miles into Carversville. Turn left on Carversville road. Turn right on Wismer Road. Turn right on Tollgate Road. Turn Right on Sladek Road. Follow Sladek Road directions above.

From Philadelphia - Take Rt. 76 West to Rt. 476 North (Blue Route) to PA Turnpike East (will say NJ and East) to exit 343 (Willow Grove) and follow the first set of directions.
