

Kruisin Kanines June agility trial opens on Tuesday, May 12th. We are not sure if this trial will be canceled as we will be complying with the Pennsylvania Governor's guidelines for opening up the State. In the event that the trial needs to be canceled, we will notify all competitors by email before the closing and all checks received will be shredded. But in the hopes that we will be able to hold the trial, we want everyone to be in a safe environment so we will be imposing new guidelines and restrictions. The old premium was taken off the Kruisin web site and the new one has replaced it,

For this trial, the following guidelines will be in affect.

1. The entry limit has changed for Saturday and Sunday from 350 runs to 200 runs per day to make it easier for social distancing.
2. There will not be any crating in the building. All crating must be from the car.
3. There will not be any chairs or observers on the mezzanine.
4. The gate steward will be outside the doorway to the building. A second gate steward will be inside the building directing people for their runs.
5. The gate steward will be the only person allowed to check in dogs.
6. Only a few exhibitors will be allowed in the building while they are in que for their runs. There will be markings on the floor at 6 foot intervals to emphasize social distancing.
7. Judges briefings will be held outside to maintain a 6 foot distance.
8. The entrance and exit of exhibitors after their runs will be different than in the past to not allow people passing closely while in the building.
9. Anyone entering the building will need to wear a mask which will include all workers and ring crew. Exhibitors do not have to wear a mask when they run, but will be required to put their mask on before and after their run.
10. Walk throughs will be limited to 10 people on the course. So depending on the amount of entries in each jump height, there may be multiple walk throughs.
11. Ribbons will be available as required by AKC. It will not be self-serve.
12. Results will be posted outside the building. In addition, results are always emailed to the exhibitors following the trial weekend.
13. Course maps will be posted outside the building. There will not be any paper course maps so plan on taking a picture of the maps.
14. There will not be food or beverages at the trial. There will not be a hospitality table. Competitors will need to bring their own food.
15. Worker bucks will be handed out to volunteers to be used at a future trial.
16. We are hoping to be able to stream the runs through Facebook Live so everyone can watch the runs from their phone or tablet outside the building. We will have a better idea if this is going to happen as we approach the closing date.

Before you enter this trial, be sure you are comfortable with these new guidelines. If anyone doesn't abide by these guidelines, they will be asked to leave this trial. We are hoping everyone will comply with the social distancing guidelines and make this trial comfortable for everyone.

This trial will probably be longer than usual, but we feel this will be the most safe way to run this trial.
